MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO . . . Samoyed Association of Minneapolis - St. Paul. Canadian Exhibitors & International Exhibitors must make checks & money orders payable in U.S. Funds.

POST DATED CHECKS, RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee of \$20.00 will be added to the amount of each returned check.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO IT'S ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The wellbeing of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES minus \$5.00 will be given to the entrants of bitches in the obedience trial & agility trial, upon written certification by a licensed veterinarian to the effect that the bitch in question is in season on the day of the trial, if received before 8:00 AM on the trial date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES except when being judged.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that Show is over, and the Secretary advised at once. The Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed at the show . . . If not, they become the property of the Show Giving Club. NO TROPHIES will be mailed.

THE SHOW SPONSORING CLUBS RESERVE THE RIGHT to substitute trophies with ones of equal or greater value.

MANAGEMENT IS NOT RESPONSIBLE for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

AWARDS OF MERIT

At the discretion of the judge, an Award of Merit may be given to the following number of dogs: The number of awards to be given will be equal to 10% of the number of specials entered at the time of closing starting with 20. This number is to be rounded downward (see chart). The number entered will disregard all absentees and transfers from the classes.

All those entered for Best of Breed Competition, plus Winners Dog & Bitch and Veteran Dog & Bitch shall be eligible to receive an Award of Merit, except the Best of Breed winner and Best of Opposite Sex winner.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES . . . Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the following Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and exactly two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as the Stud Dog. Stud Dogs MUST be entered in the Stud Dog class and be shown in the ring with their Get. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee; this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is also entered in another class. The Stud Dog may be neutered if and only if Stud Dog Class and Veteran Class are the only classes entered. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog; Produce for Get; and the Brood Bitch may be spayed.

BRACE CLASS - For two dogs, of the same or different sexes with the exact same owner or owners.

NOTE: The Brace Class is considered as one entry and only one additional entry fee is paid unless dogs are entered in Brace class only, in which case the regular entry fee is paid for each dog not entered in another class.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

This Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Samoyeds at least six months of age, and under eighteen months, on the day of the show, except that no dog or bitch bred by this judge or member of his immediate family, nor any dog or bitch sired by a dog owned by this judge or member of his immediate family, may be entered. All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class and entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as for the Regular Classes. Entries in Puppy Sweepstakes shall be indicated on the entry form in the space marked "Additional Classes" by the use of the word "Sweepstakes" and the Class Division.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATION

DIVISION OF SWEEPSTAKES ENTRY PRIZE MONEY

35% of the entry money will be retained by the club for expenses. 10% shall be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes; and 5% shall be awarded to Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes. The remaining 50% shall be divided as follows for each class:

For classes with one entry: First; \$6.25.

For classes with two entries: First; \$6.50, Second; \$6.00.

For classes with three entries: First; \$6.95, Second; \$6.20, Third; \$5.60

Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in a Regular Class.

DIVISION OF SWEEPSTAKES ENTRY PRIZE MONEY

35% of the entry money will be retained by the club for expenses. 10% shall be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes; and 5% shall be awarded to Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes. The remaining 50% shall be divided as follows for each class:

This agility trial is open to all Samoyeds, twelve (12) months of age or older, who additionally meet all eligibility requirements described in Chapter 1, Section 3, *Regulations for Agility Trials*, American Kennel Club. The safety of the dogs that compete in this trial is a primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. A qualifying score is required for all prizes. "Dog" when applied here means either sex.

CLASSIFICATION

Both STD & JWW classes with all levels will be offered at this trial.

MOVE-UPS are allowed per Chapter 1, Section 12, *American Kennel Club Regulations For Agility Trials*. Move-ups will be accepted up until 6:00 pm on May 16th. S.A.M.S. will offer move-ups from Saturday to Sunday at this set of trials. Moveups for Sunday must be to trial secretary within 1 hour after completion of Agility Trial on Saturday.

Measuring

All dogs competing in agility will be required to present an official AKC jump height card prior to running in an AKC agility trial. All dogs except those jumping 24" (unless a VMO or AKC Rep is present) with out permanent or temporary height cards will be measured. This trial will accept photocopies of the permanent or current temporary height card with the entry for this trial. Exhibitor must be able to show height card at trial if requested, even if sent to Trial Secretary, AKC rule.

Obstacle Familiarization

Obstacle familiarization will NOT be offered at these trials.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and appropriate vaccinations. Per Minnesota regulations, exhibitors must be able to show proof of rabies vaccination.

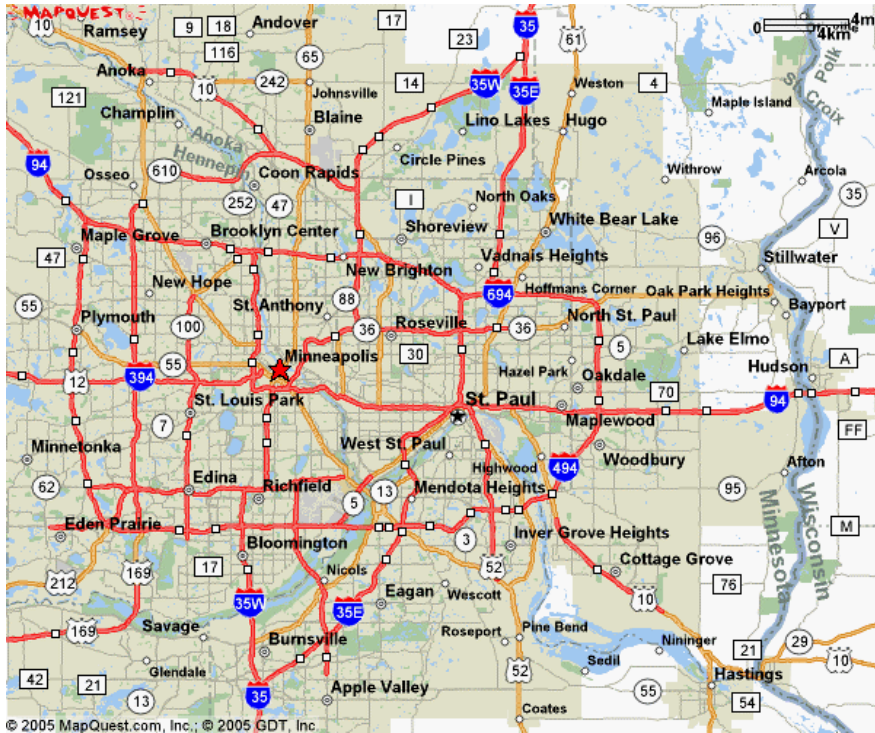

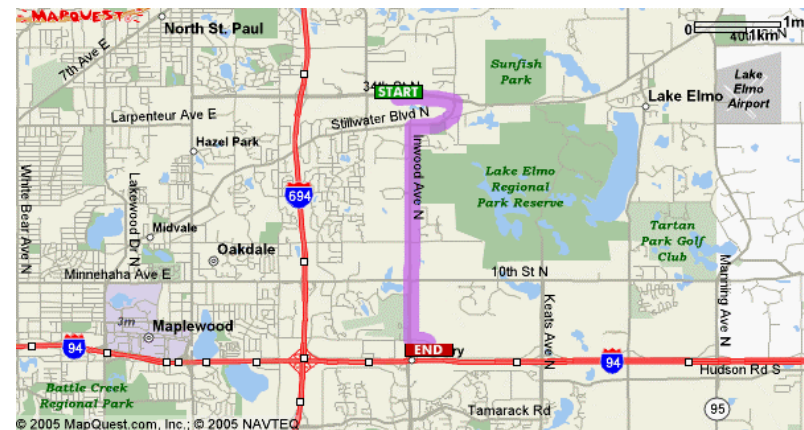
